

MILESTONE™, CLEARVIEW™ AND SIGHTLINE™ HERBICIDES USE AROUND TREES

HERBICIDE

Milestone, ClearView and Sightline herbicides may have activity on woody species, including trees, when applied to the soil within the root zone. Milestone, ClearView and Sightline should not be used as a spray application under the tree canopy, nor should they be used over the top of desirable trees. Milestone, ClearView and Sightline should only be used up to the drip line (outermost edge of the tree canopy) of desirable trees. They can be applied up to the drip line of the following species:

- Ash
- Aspen
- Black cherry
- Birch
- Cottonwood
- Dogwood
- Eastern white pine
- Elm
- Fir
- Junipers
- Maple
- Oaks
- Sweetgum
- Willow
- Poplar
- Ponderosa and lodgepole pines
(may cause transient leaf curling
that will disappear)
- Spruce species

Caution: DO NOT use Milestone, ClearView or Sightline over the top of, or directly under, any desirable tree species; injury or death can result from foliar applications to trees.

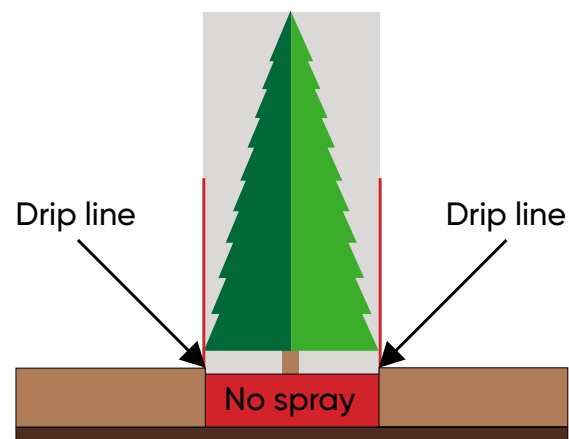

Use caution when using Milestone, ClearView and Sightline around the following species. Greatest caution should be taken around those species with extensive lateral root systems, shallow rooting species and those that propagate vegetatively through layering. An additional buffer from the drip line may be required for the following susceptible leguminous and other tree species:

- Black locust
- Caragana
- Cedar
- Honey locust
- Mimosa
- Other locust species
- Redbud
- Rose
